Computer Requirements	All students are required to have a PC or Mac laptop available for daily use in the classroom. All laptops must be capable of running the full Logos Bible Software program. The full program is only available for PC's and Mac computers. Students may not consider Chrome Books or tablets as their daily device. All new students may use the cost of the laptop when calculating Federal Student Aid. All returning students needing a laptop or wanting to upgrade may also use the cost of the laptop when calculating Federal Student Aid. <b>Students must have a receipt to claim this one-time added cost.</b>		
Logos Bible Software	All degree and certificate seeking students at Summit Christian College are required to purchase a Logos Bible Software library through Summit Christian College. This library will be used at all levels of the student's studies at Summit. This library is specific to Summit Christian College. If a student already has a Logos library, they <b>MUST</b> speak to the Academic Dean to confirm the library is adequate. The purchase of the Logos Bible Software Library is made through the materials fee during the enrollment process. New students will pay \$175 in the Fall and Spring Semesters. If both payments are made, the student will keep the Logos Bible Software Library permanently. If a student does not make both payments, the user permissions will be revoked and the library will be returned to the college. During the first week of classes students will receive instructions for downloading the software and library. Some textbooks are required to purchase through Logos Bible Software. These textbooks are in a purple font. If students have questions on textbooks required through Logos, please contact the professor. New students are encouraged to wait until New Student Orientation, when they will be given instructions for downloading the software and library, to purchase these texts required in Logos.
