<b>Logos Bible Software</b>	<p>All degree and certificate seeking students at Summit Christian College are required to purchase a Logos Bible Software library through Summit Christian College. This library will be used at all levels of the student's studies at Summit. This library is specific to Summit Christian College. If a student already has a Logos library, they <b>MUST</b> speak to the Academic Dean to confirm the library is adequate.</p> <p>The purchase of the Logos Bible Software Library is made through the materials fee during the enrollment process. New students will pay \$175 in the Fall and Spring Semesters. If both payments are made, the student will keep the Logos Bible Software Library permanently. If a student does not make both payments, the user permissions will be revoked and the library will be returned to the college.</p> <p>During the first week of classes students will receive instructions for downloading the software and library.</p>
